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## Investment Objective and Strategies

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The Evolve Global Materials & Mining Enhanced Yield Index ETF (the "Fund") seeks to replicate, to the extent reasonably possible and before fees and expenses, the performance of the Solactive Global Materials & Mining Index (the "Benchmark"), or any successor thereto, while mitigating downside risk. The Fund invests directly or indirectly in equity securities of global issuers engaged in the manufacturing, mining and/or integration of metals and materials, while writing covered call options on up to 33% of the portfolio securities, at the direction of the portfolio manager. The level of covered call option writing may vary based on market volatility and other factors.

## Risk

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There were no changes to the Fund over the period of this report that materially affected the level of risk associated with an investment in the Fund. Prospective investors should read the Fund's most recent prospectus and consider the description of risks contained therein.

## Results of Operations

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For the six-month period ended June 30, 2024, the Hedged ETF Units returned -3.3% versus the Solactive Materials & Mining Index PR CAD hedge return of -4.9%. The Unhedged ETF Units returned -1.0% versus the Solactive Materials & Mining Index PR return of -1.5%. The difference in performance of the hedged units relative to its benchmark can be attributed primarily to management and administration fees plus applicable sales taxes, to portfolio trading and hedging strategies and to the assumption that all distributions made by the investment fund were reinvested in additional securities whereas the index performance is of price return only. Furthermore, the difference can also be attributed to the implementation of the call writing strategy where the Fund tends to outperform in flat or down markets and underperform during sharp market advances. This performance difference can be seen over the period the calls are written, typically with one to two months to expiry, and then resets when new option positions are established. The Fund's net assets were \$72.8MM as at June 30, 2024.

## Portfolio Manager Commentary

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The first half of 2024 has been notably strong for the materials and mining industry. Commodities, particularly copper, are hovering near all-time highs<sup>1</sup>, driven by surging demand. This demand is primarily fueled by the global boom in data centers and renewable energy projects<sup>2</sup>, which has significantly increased the need for copper and steel in their development. Gold also reached an all-time high in May<sup>3</sup>, spurred by inflation data that has reinvigorated its role as a safe-haven asset for investors. This peak reflects broader trends in the market as investors seek stability amidst economic fluctuations.

Mergers and acquisitions have been a dominant theme in the industry during the period, as global players seek to bridge supply gaps and consolidate resources<sup>4</sup>. Notably, US Steel is in the process of closing its acquisition of Nippon Steel, a strategic move to enhance its production capabilities. BHP also completed a significant acquisition of an Australian minerals company, Oz Minerals, for \$6.4 billion, bolstering its copper portfolio and reinforcing its position in the minerals market. These strategic acquisitions highlight the proactive steps taken by major industry players to secure essential resources and maintain competitive advantages.

In summary, the materials and mining industry has experienced a prosperous first half of 2024. The sustained high demand for copper and steel, record-breaking gold prices, and significant M&A activities have collectively driven the industry's strong performance during the period.

## Performance Attribution

For the six-month period ending June 30, 2024, Southern Copper Corporation made the biggest contribution to the Fund, followed by Steel Dynamics Inc. By weight, the Fund's largest holdings were DuPont de Nemours Inc., Newmont Corporation, and AngloGold Ashanti Plc.

## Recent Developments

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There are no known changes at this time to the investment strategy of the Fund or the Manager.

## Related Party Transactions

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Evolve Funds Group Inc. (the "Manager") complies with its current policy and procedures regarding investments in related issuers and reports periodically to the Investment Review Committee.

## Management Fees

The management fees are calculated based on 0.60% per annum of the average daily net asset value of the Fund. The fees are accrued daily and are generally paid monthly. For the six-month period ended June 30, 2024, the Fund incurred \$216,673 in management fees. These management fees were received by the Manager for the day-to-day operations of the fund, including managing the portfolio, maintaining portfolio systems used to manage the Fund, maintaining the [www.evolveetfs.com](http://www.evolveetfs.com) website, and providing all other services including marketing and promotion.

## Administration Fees

The administration fees are calculated based on 0.15% per annum of the average daily net asset value of the Fund. The fees are accrued daily and are generally paid monthly. For the six-month period ended June 30, 2024, the Fund incurred \$55,056 in administration fees. These administration fees were received by the Manager for the following operating expenses of the Fund including but not limited to: mailing and printing expenses for periodic reports to unitholders; Registrar and Transfer Agent and Custodian; any reasonable out of pocket expenses incurred by the Manager or its agents in connection with their ongoing obligations to the Fund; IRC committee member fees and expenses in connection with the IRC; expenses related to compliance with NI 81-107; fees and expenses relating to voting of proxies by a third party; insurance coverage for the members of the IRC; fees payable to the auditors and legal advisors of the Fund; regulatory filing, stock exchange and licensing fees and CDS fees; costs and expenses of complying with all applicable laws, regulations and policies, including expenses and costs incurred in connection with the continuous public filing requirements such as permitted prospectus preparation and filing expenses; and legal, accounting and audit fees and fees and expenses of the Trustee, Custodian and Manager which are incurred in respect of matters not in the normal course of the Fund's activities. The administration fee paid to the Manager by the Fund may, in any particular period, be less than or exceed the operating expenses that the Manager incurs for the Fund.

6 The trading expense ratio represents total commissions and other portfolio transaction costs expressed as an annualized percentage of average daily net assets during the period.

7 The Fund's portfolio turnover rate indicates how actively the Fund's portfolio manager trades its portfolio investments. A portfolio turnover rate of 100% is equivalent to the Fund buying and selling all of the securities in its portfolio once in the course of the period. The higher the Fund's portfolio turnover rate in a period, the greater the trading costs payable by the Fund in the period, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the period. There is not necessarily a relationship between a high turnover rate and the performance of a fund.

## Past Performance

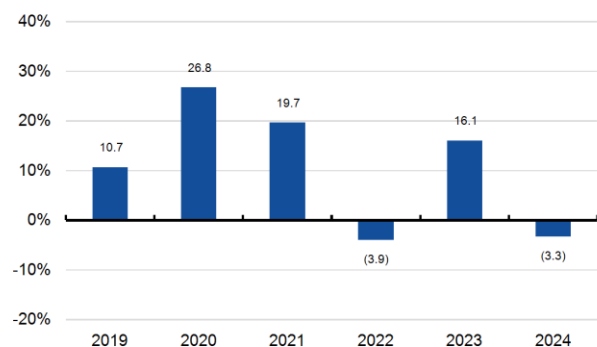
## Year-by-Year Returns

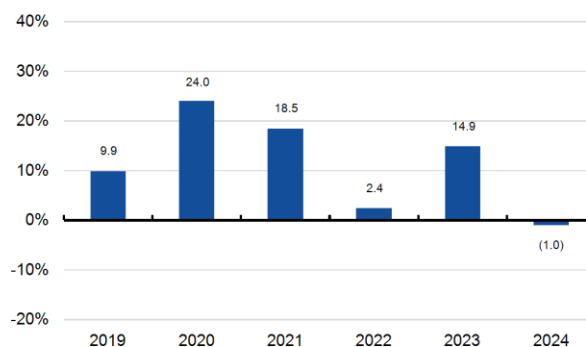
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## BASE Hedged ETF Units<sup>1</sup>
