Interim Management Report of Fund Performance

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Investment Objective and Strategies

The Premium Cash Management Fund (the "Fund") seeks to maximize current income, while at the same time preserving capital and maintaining liquidity, by investing primarily in Canadian dollar-denominated high-quality short term debt securities (with a term to maturity of 365 days or less).

Risk

There were no changes to the Fund over the period of this report that materially affected the level of risk associated with an investment in the Fund. Prospective investors should read the Fund's most recent prospectus and consider the description of risks contained therein.

Results of Operations

Since the Fund effectively began operations on May 26, 2023, no performance data can be shown. The Fund's net assets were \$35.2MM as at June 30, 2023.

Portfolio Manager Commentary

The Canadian money market has demonstrated its strength over the first half of 2023, especially amidst the significant rate hikes by the Bank of Canada since March 2022. More specifically, the Bank of Canada has raised the target overnight rate from 0.25% to 4.75% since March 2022, including two 0.25% rate hikes in January and June of 2023.¹ This shift has underpinned the opportunity in the Canadian money market for those investors seeking to benefit from rising interest rates while preserving capital. Despite the fact that Canada's annual inflation rate dropped by a percentage point to 3.4% in May of 2023, the Bank of Canada is expected to continue its tightening cycle, further enhancing the appeal of money market investment products.²

Yet, the first half of 2023 has not been without its challenges. Bonds had a volatile period with fluctuating yields causing notable price moves, creating circumstances which have not been seen since the Global Financial Crisis. This volatility highlights the ongoing uncertainty in monetary policy direction and economic data variability.³

Given the mixed economic indicators, with softening employment data and cooling headline inflation on one hand, and core inflation levels above the Bank of Canada's target on the other, it's a tricky balancing act for policymakers. Economic conditions such as these have solidified the importance of capital preservation and liquidity offered through money market investment products.³

Related Party Transactions

Evolve Funds Group Inc. (the "Manager") complies with its current policy and procedures regarding investments in related issuers and reports periodically to the Investment Review Committee.

Management Fees

The Manager is entitled to an annual management fee of 0.20% of the net asset value of the Unhedged ETF Units and the Unhedged Class F Mutual Fund Units and 0.45% of the net asset value of the 0 the Unhedged Class A Mutual Fund Units of the Fund, accrued daily and generally paid monthly in arrears. Since the Fund's inception, the Manager has waived the management fee on the Unhedged ETF Units and the Unhedged Class F Mutual Fund Units of the Fund until December 31, 2023. The Manager has reduced the management fee on the Unhedged Class A Mutual Fund Units of the Fund until December 31, 2023. The Manager has reduced the management fee on the Unhedged Class A Mutual Fund Units of the Fund to the amount of the trailing commission payable to a Unitholder's dealer until December 31, 2023. The effective annual management fee for the Unhedged Class A Mutual Fund Units is 0.25%. For the six-month period ended June 30, 2023, the Fund incurred \$357 in management fees. These management fees were received by the Manager for the day-to-day operations of the fund, including managing the portfolio, maintaining portfolio systems used to manage the Fund, maintaining the www.evolveetfs.com website, and providing all other services including marketing and promotion.

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Administration Fees

The administration fees are calculated based on 0.05% per annum of the average daily net asset value of the Fund. The fees are accrued daily and are generally paid monthly. For the six-month period ended June 30, 2023, the Fund incurred \$765 in administration fees. These administration fees were received by the Manager for the following operating expenses of the Fund including but not limited to: mailing and printing expenses for periodic reports to unitholders; Registrar and Transfer Agent and Custodian; any reasonable out of pocket expenses incurred by the Manager or its agents in connection with their ongoing obligations to the Fund; IRC committee member fees and expenses in connection with the IRC; expenses related to compliance with NI 81-107; fees and expenses relating to voting of proxies by a third party; insurance coverage for the members of the IRC; fees payable to the auditors and legal advisors of the Fund; regulatory filing, stock exchange and licensing fees and CDS fees; costs and expenses of complying with all applicable laws, regulations and policies, including expenses; and legal, accounting and audit fees and fees and expenses of the Trustee, Custodian and Manager which are incurred in respect of matters not in the normal course of the Fund's activities. The administration fee paid to the Manager by the Fund may, in any particular period, be less than or exceed the operating expenses that the Manager incurs for the Fund.
